Minutes of the meeting

- **1.** Sri Prabhas Choudhuri pointed out the importance of mentoring of undergraduate students in the present scenario. He also added that teachers of the department will be the mentors
- 2. However Dr Indrajit Chakraborty, briefed the mentoring strategies adopted in other educational institutes and mentioned the need of external mentors. A Group of core Mentors may be created under which internal and external mentors be framed.
- 3. Dr. Manas Kumar Baidya, Bursar, pointed out that the mentoring strategies should be different from adopted previously and external mentors should be introduced.

- 4. Dr. Akhileshwar prasad also shared the same opinion and pointed out that that the mentoring committee should frame a list that clearly indicates the name of external and internal mentors.
- 5. Dr. Narayan chandra Shaw, also shared the same opinion and stressed that the mentees will be assigned to internal mentors and external mentors will act as supervisor in need.
- 6. Dr Baidya pointed out the need of online mode of Examination to be implemented from this year to equip the students in the present competitive scenario.
- 7. Chairperson , Sri Prabhas Chaudhuri, pointed out that in perspective of the physical fitness of the students, a Gymnasium can be built.

Resolutions Adopted:

The meeting was presided over by Sri. Prabhas Chowdhuri, Teacher in Charge and Chairperson of IQAC, Malda College. The resolutions of the previous meeting were read out by the Coordinator and the same was ratified unanimously.

Item no-1

- 1) The Coordinator brought to the notice of the members that the existing mentoring system of the College has not been very successful. After elaborate discussions it was decided that the model should be changed so that it can be effective and in harmony with the ecosystem of the college. Hence it is resolved that:
 - a) There will be two types of mentors, "Internal Mentors" and "External Mentors".
 - b) All the teachers of the Departments will be "Internal Mentors" and one teacher from another department will serve as "External Mentors".
 - c) The students who need mentoring will be assigned to the Internal Mentors. The Internal Mentors shall be mainly responsible for mentoring. They will also maintain a proper documentation of all mentees regularly. The external mentor will meet his/her assigned mentees once every month.
 - d) The external mentor will have a supervisory role. If the students face any problem with the internal mentor they may approach the external mentors or the core committee members.
 - e) The mentoring committee will frame the detailed procedure and list of mentors as per the above resolutions and implement the changes as soon as possible.

Item No-2

An Orientation programme of newly admitted students of UG under all programmes will be organised by the IQAC. It was resolved that the IQAC Coordinator will aware the students about their activities for their upcoming three years.

Item no -3

Resolved that a Central computer laboratory be developed at room no-229 to accommodate as many as 80 computers to facilitate practical classes as well as online tests. Sri Kankar Sarkar, ASsistant professor In Mathematics, be requested to take the responsibility to develop and run the computer laboratory as soon as possible

Item no - 4

Resolved that a central gymnasium be built at the Indoor stadium of Malda College where students will get free access of the gymnasium facilities. A Gymnasium Committee will be formed to monitor the same.

Item no - 5

The college sweepers collects solid wastes daily from the college campus and hostels and municipality vehicles collect those garbages for safe disposal. So it has been resolved unanimously to increase the frequency of the visit of the Municipality garbage van. Also resolved that a solid waste repository be prepared at the college campus. Regarding e waste management and safe disposal, it was resolved that steps will be initiated by the Green Campus Committee in collaboration with DCSA.

The meeting has been presided over by Dr. Manas Kumar Baidya, Principal and Chairperson of IQAC, Malda College. The resolutions of the previous meeting were read out by the Coordinator and the same has been ratified unanimously.

- 1. After discussing the challenges and changes due to the implementation of CBCS syllabus it was resolved that:
 - a) To clarify the various confusions arising due to the implementation of CBCS syllabus a team of teachers along with the Principal will meet the University Authorities and will try to organise a workshop as soon as possible.

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- b) In view of the computer related practicals in many programmes, a central computer laboratory will be set up. To set up the lab, each existing PC's will be used as servers with 5 or 6 thin clients based terminals. Sri Kankan Sarkar will oversee this process.
- c) All the departments will prepare a fresh syllabus breakup, lecture layout and course outcome. The same will be displayed on the Departmental website. However, the older breakup and course outcome shall be preserved as the same will be needed for NAAC.
- 2. Online admission process through ERP has been successfully implemented from the current academic session. But regarding the suggestion put forward by the admission committee, it is resolved that a general convention will be held at Durgakinkar Sadan prior to the commencement of admission of 2019-20 to guide the applicants for error free submission of online forms.
- 3. Chairperson, Dr Manas Kumar Baidya, pointed to the fact that college website should be made page responsive for easy access to the students. So, resolved that the existing vendor, Magic Nines infotech Pvt Limited will develop the same as soon as possible.
- 4. In view of the present water scarcity all around the world and the depletion of ground water level at Malda college, it is being resolved that a Rainwater harvesting tank can be built up at the college campus and steps be initiated to get financial assistance from the English bazar municipality. Green campus committee will take further initiatives regarding it. Also resolved that a deep bore well be constructed as a measure for ground water recharging. Mr Jagdip chauhan, Assistant Professor, will take charge of it.
- 5. In view of the success of the Add-On course on Tailoring it is resolved that the college will purchase the necessary sewing machines and the Machines lent by Ms. Joya Roy will be returned with thanks. Fluency in English is now a mandatory skill required for the applicants in a job interview. Regarding it, an add-on course can be started on Communicative English and steps be initiated to by The HOD, Department of English.
- 6. Bursar, Sri Arup Roy Chowdhury, has proposed to felicitate the Departmental Rank holders (1st & 2nd) to encourage the current year students.

It is resolved that a Central Felicitation Programme be held during the month of December 2019. Rank holders of the last five academic years (2014-2019) will be felicitated in this programme.
